<p><b>Day 6: Returning to Sambava</b></p> <p>Today you will be traveling back to Sambava, the main hub for vanilla trade in the region.</p> <p>You will have the entire day to explore and choose activities that interest you the most.</p> <p>You may consider visiting the <b>Sacred Lake Antahomaro</b>, home to numerous crocodiles. Alternatively, you can tour one of the largest <b>coconut plantations</b> in the world or visit a <b>vanilla processing facility</b> to learn more about the production process.</p> <p>In any case, there are plenty of opportunities to purchase high-quality vanilla pods at attractive prices.</p>	 <p>A small, spiny hedgehog (Tenrec ecaudatus) is seen in its natural habitat.
